

**NOTICE TO ALL ATTORNEYS ENTERING AN APPEARANCE IN A GUARDIANSHIP PROCEEDING:**

In accordance with Texas Estates Code 1054.201, an attorney representing any person's interests in a guardianship proceeding, including an attorney ad litem, must be certified by the State Bar of Texas as having successfully completed a course of study in guardianship law and procedure sponsored by the state bar or the state bar's designee. The State Bar of Texas requires four hours of credit for certification.
