

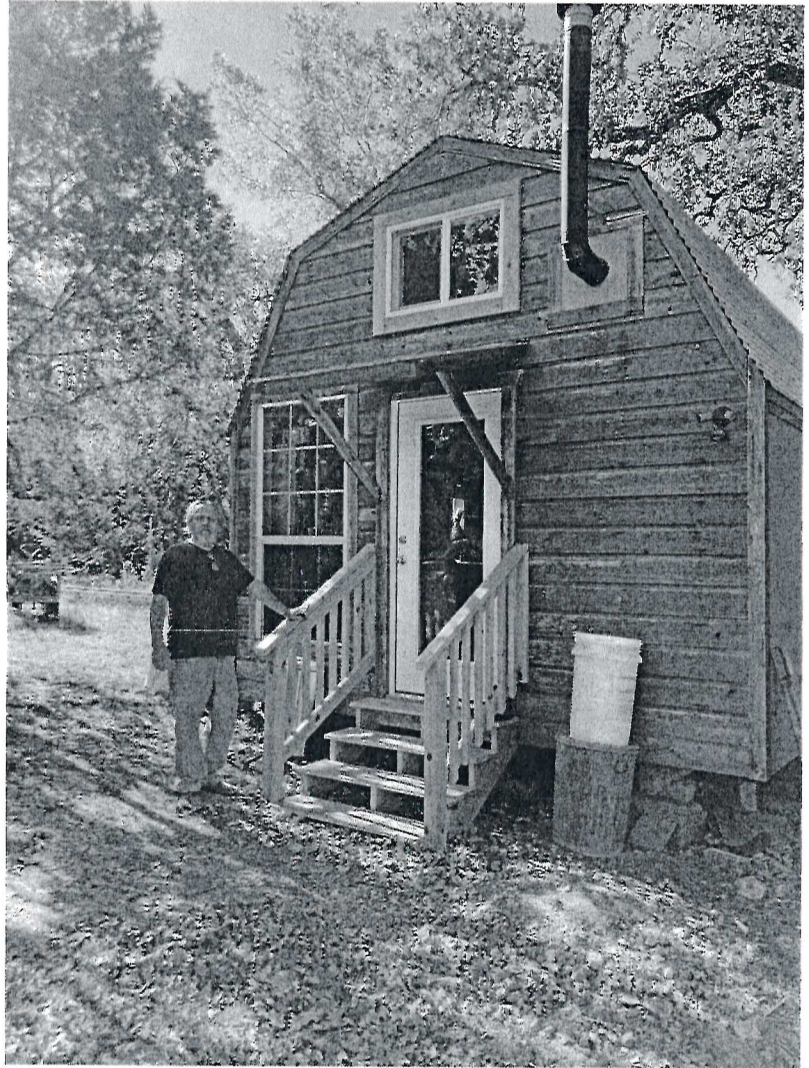
# Dean's House

# Home Repair

## Program Description and Application Process

### Home Repair Program Description

Fredericksburg's Habitat for Humanity's Home Repair Program is focused on making repairs that improve home safety and livability for the homeowners we serve.

The program is open to all households that meet our eligibility requirements and typically serves seniors and people with disabilities.

### Eligibility requirements

- You must own and live in the home
- Your total household income must be less than \$51,550/year
- Your house must be in Gillespie county or have a Fredericksburg, TX address

### Home Repair Application Process:

Request an application by email to [fbghabitat.secretary@gmail.org](mailto:fbghabitat.secretary@gmail.org), fill it out and send it back.

Members of the Fredericksburg Habitat for Humanity Board will review your application. You will be contacted to request a visit at your home to define the scope of work.

Upon approval, Habitat for Humanity Fredericksburg will hire a contractor to perform the repairs and you will be asked to sign a contract along with Habitat for Humanity Fredericksburg and the contractor defining the scope of work, costs, schedule and to allow the work to occur on your property.

Repayment requirements, if any, will be defined in a separate contract between you and Fredericksburg Habitat for Humanity.
