

VISION: As the nation's premier nonprofit organization, PHWFF envisions a community where all participants can heal.

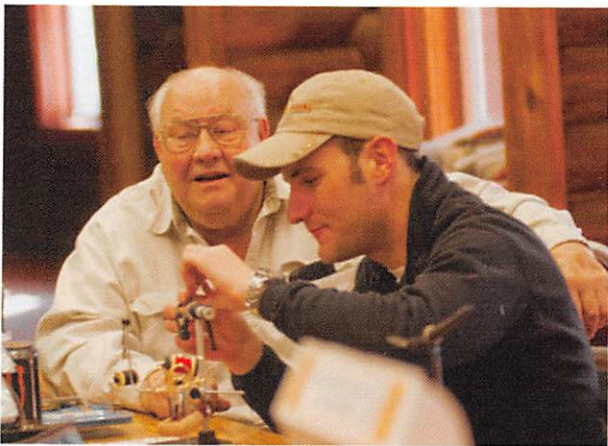
CORE VALUES: PHWFF holds the following core values as central to our success

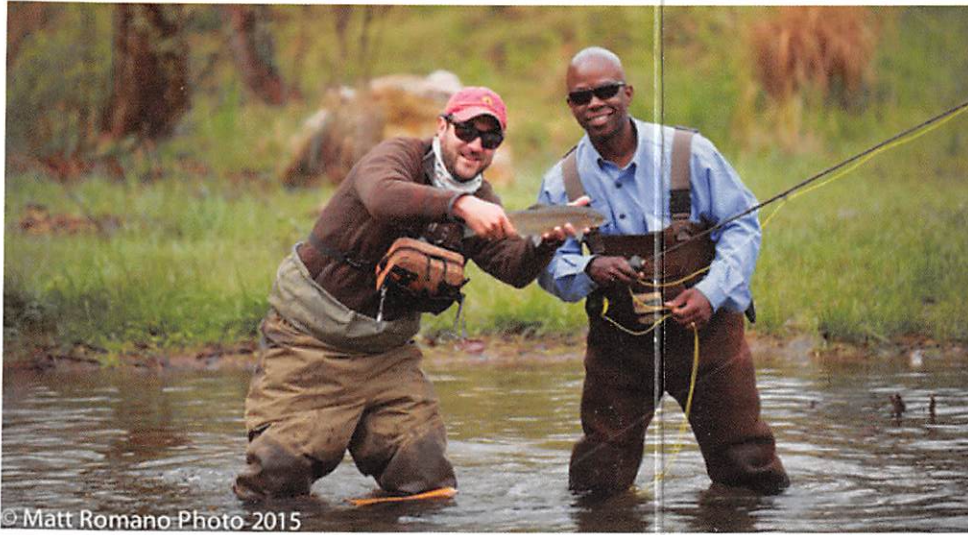

In 2017 alone, 3,200 PHWFF volunteers served over 8,400 injured and disabled military service personnel and disabled veterans across

no cost. Fishing trips, both one day and multi-day, are also provided free of charge to participants

PHWFF is unique in that our volunteers are teaching classes on an on-going, long term basis. It is much more than a one-time fishing trip. For many participants, the socialization and camaraderie of the classes are just as important as the fishing outings, and provide them a new activity and community. We provide the lifeline that connects disabled veterans with our volunteers and programs in a long-term healing relationship.

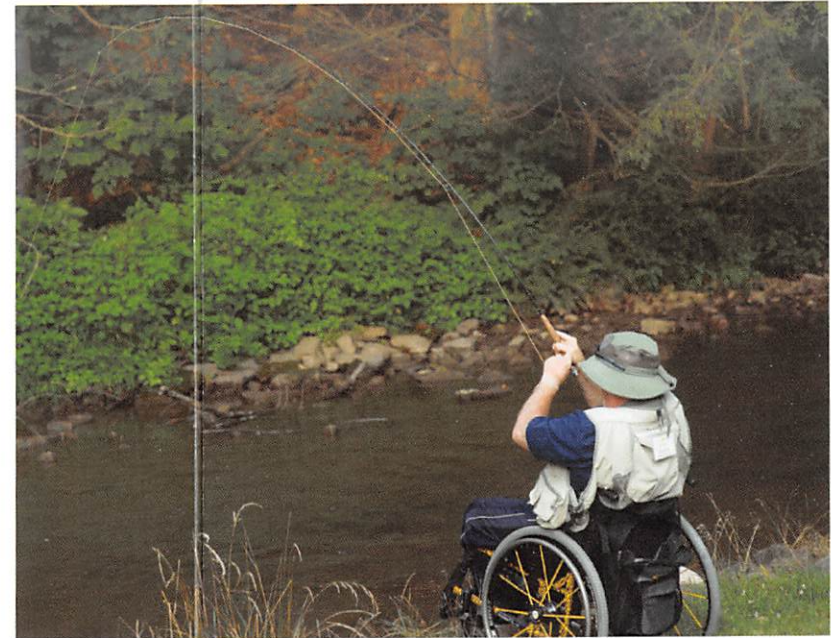
PROJECT HEALING WATERS FLY FISHING INC. (PHWFF) is dedicated to the physical and emotional rehabilitation of disabled active military service personnel and disabled veterans through fly fishing and associated activities including education and outings. PHWFF formed in 2005 serving disabled military service members and disabled veterans at Walter Reed Army Medical Center. Since then, PHWFF has expanded nationwide, establishing over 200 highly successful, volunteer-run

The PHWFF program provides basic fly fishing, fly casting, fly tying and rod building classes, along with clinics, for participants ranging from beginners who have never fished before, to those with prior fly fishing and tying experience.
