Volunteers of America Texas provides housing stabilization services to veterans and their families in south central Texas who are facing homelessness. Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) helps these families secure housing and essential services.

Who's eligible

Veterans and their families

Individual or family where the head of household or spouse is a veteran with an honorable discharge.

Low-income

Income is 50% or below of the area's median income determined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Living in south central Texas

Bastrop, Bell, Blanco, Burnet, Caldwell, Comal, Coryell, Gillepsie, Gonzales, Guadalupe, Hays, Kendall, Kerr and Williamson counties.

Homeless or near homeless

Resides in a shelter, on the street or in danger of losing housing.


Services include
