DEDICATED USE HANGAR FOR CORPORATE OR PRIVATE USE LETTER OF INTENT GUIDELINES – Ph i

The Proposal Letter (to the Airport Advisory Board) should address in non-technical terms the following general questions:

- 1. Where? Locate the site of the proposed hangar, preferably with a sketch, and general description of location.
- 2. What? Describe land requirements by consideration of (a) hangar foot-print, (b) dedicated aircraft ramp, (c) Taxi-Lane (if necessary), (d) access road (if necessary).
- 3. Services Considerations? Minimum services provided in the hangar should include Electric, Telephone, Water and Sanitary Sewer. Toilet(s) should be provided in the hangar. Clarify how you will support these services.
- 4. **Minimum Hangar Building?** Appendix A of Airport Rules and Regulations states requirements. In general, Pre-engineered metal building, on reinforced concrete pad, of minimum dimensions 80' Depth X 62' Width and H' Height, where H is sufficient to accept a hangar door of minimum clear opening of 16' Height X 58' width. A dedicated Aircraft Ramp should be provided, of same width as the hangar building door side and 25' depth. This ramp should be constructed to Taxi-Lane spec on acceptable base material with hot-mix asphalt. Clarify how you will support these requirements.
- 5. Other Considerations? Will office space and/or work-shop facilities be constructed inside the hangar? Clarify.
- 6. Who Pays for What? Your proposal letter should make clear what you propose to pay for and what you expect the County of Gillespie to provide.
- 7. Rent and Lease Term? What do you propose?
